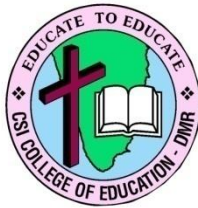

## **A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE COLLEGE**

In 1840, to ameliorate the oppressed society by tradition, Missionaries had established Educational Institutions and Hospitals to reach the common men which was till then forbidden. Realization of education as a tool for development made many of our ancestors to avail the facilities unmindful of making a long journey by walk and daring the prevailing diseases like plaque and cholera. Affordable and free boarding attracted many parents to get their children educated in the remote under develop area of Ramanathapuram district. Among such pioneering Centres were, the abode of Missionaries.

Presently, the Diocese of Madurai-Ramnad has 182 Institutions (174 schools) with 1700 Teaching faculty and 45,000 students learning at various levels. B.Ed Colleges (2), Dental College, Arts & Science College & J.A. College of Nursing to serve the society at tertiary level. The late Rt. Rev. Dr. A. Christopher Asir our former Bishop established two B.Ed colleges in Pasumalai and Ramnad (2006) with the academic guidance of Dr.J.P.Gabriel (Ret. Prof. Education M.K. University). Further developments were under the prophetic guidance of the present Bishop Rt. Rev. Dr. M. Joseph and office bearers.

3. The Faculty members are encouraged to undertake research works particularly Ph.D to develop their career. Rs.2500/- is provided for every year to the faculty as a token of encouragement to initiate their research work.

## **GENERAL DISCIPLINE**

1. College Calendar provides the annual plan and facilities as prior intimation. The College ID card and Uniform shall be worn by every student in the campus on stipulated days.
2. Availing the extra curricular activities is encouraged as part of enhancing teaching potentials.
3. Mobile Phone contact to lecturers for clarifying doubts between 6 to 8 pm is permitted and not other wise, but use during class time is forbidden.
4. Every student shall Endeavour to attend classes regularly and completing the tasks assigned daily like notes of lesson and observation Record ect.

5. Use of computer is a basic requirement and hence those who wish can acquire training in the college computer centre which will be helpful for the preparation of Power Point Show slide preparation or Computer Assisted Learning material.
6. Students are expected to spend their leisure hours in library or in the workshop or in the computer web centre. They shall not loiter on the road side shops or canteen or the school campus.
7. Student Counselling is available. Problematic students can avail assistance confidentially from the counseling cell.
8. Any student found to be indifferent or careless on his / her work or whose conduct is considered to be detrimental to the best interest of the college, is liable to punishment which may extend to expulsion from the college.
9. Every student shall handle college property with care and do everything in his power to preserve the cleanliness of the buildings, furniture and grounds. Any damage done to the properties of the College will be repaired at the cost of the students causing damage. Any willful damage is a considered as serious offence.
10. During teaching practices, daily attendance is compulsory. Prior permission will not be encouraged except at dire needs. Daily consultation with the guide is

encouraged through mobile link system..

11. Teaching materials like models, working models, charts, etc should be developed individually to acquire skill, not to be bought.
12. All the vehicles must be kept in the parking areas meant for them. And rash driving anywhere is discouraged. Honour traffic rules in public.
13. The field trips or education tours shall be organized only by the respective departments, only under the supervision of the faculty and students should not take private trips among themselves.
14. By accepting membership in the College, students accept obligation to obey its rules and to respect and support its discipline. In the interpretation of the rule and in any academic or disciplinary matter not covered so far, they are expected to accept the guidance of the College authorities.

### **WORK SCHEDULE**

1. Attendance will be marked at the beginning of each class
2. Students shall assemble in the respective lecture rooms before the second bell, after the Morning Prayer.
3. No student shall absent himself / herself from the College without obtaining leave, except in case of sudden illness or other circumstances which may prevent him / her from so doing. The Principal / Vice - Principal is the authority for granting leave.

4. Application for leave must be written, specifying clearly the reasons. They must be countersigned by the Parent or Guardian or Warden before being sent to the Principal / Vice-Principal. Sick leave exceeding two days should be supported by medical certificate.
5. Students must be in college by 9.15 AM, Late coming should be avoided.
6. If a student absents himself / herself from College without leave, he shall pay a fine according to the existing rules.
7. Any student who needs permission must write a letter stating the reason and get it countersigned by the Principal / Vice-Principal.
8. There will be scheduled classes during all college programs and activities for the rest, excepting participants.
9. Girl students can use the Hosteller's Rest Room, when needed.

### **HOSTEL RULES**

(Separate Boys and Girls Hostel available)

1. MESS : Food will be served on contract Mess Meal hours are : Breakfast 7.30 - 8.30 a.m. Lunch 12.45- 1.15p.m. Dinner 7.30 - 8.00p.m.

Rebate on Mess : A rebate on mess charge is allowed only in cases of absence for three or more continuous days.

2. Keeping costly items like Jewellery, Money and Cell Phone is at students risk, else deposited with warden.
3. CLOSING TIME: The Gate closing time is 7.30 p.m. A member, who by some unavoidable cause is detained elsewhere after the closing time, should Telephone to warden and shall on return, write his / her name and sign and make the appropriate entries in the Late Book. When a large number of students return after counselling or academic activities, late book entries may not be required. Closing time on Saturdays and days preceding holidays will be 9.p.m.
4. Watching TV or DVD or laptop or video is discouraged.
5. Telephoning at late night should be avoided, Gathering in rooms and discussing be limited. Drinking alcohol or smoking is not permitted.
6. HALL PRAYERS : Prayers will be held at 7.00 p.m. in the Hall.
7. VISITORS - Relatives registered alone are permitted but male members are not permitted to enter into girls' hostel.
8. STUDY : Study period will be observed generally between 8.00 p. m. - 10.00 p.m. This period is meant for maintaining absolute silence and for Academic work. Any kind of activity which disturbs others will never be permitted.

9. Dr. Margarett (Raju Clinic) will take care for minor ailments, for 24 hour care. Private clinic is also available next door.

10. The Cleanliness of the rooms is the duty of the Hosteller. Avoid wastage of food, water and electricity and use dust bins in Toilets.

11. Day scholars are not allowed to enter the Hostel rooms, but can use main hall in the Hostel as rest room. Hostellers can meet visitors in the main hall.

12. Stay back at room during working days is restricted to health reason and on permission.

13. Iron box, Induction stove and heating rods should not be used in the rooms.

14. Cell Phones can be charged, but its use must be limited.

15. Attendance will be taken in the Morning 6.00 AM and at 7. 30 PM in the night.

16. An Outgoing Register will be kept in the Hostel and students should sign in the register, writing the time of going out and coming in.

17. In case of any emergency, the residential warden will take care at any time.

## **EXAMINATION**

4. Any student found sprinkling coloured material in the college premises or on other students is liable for serious disciplinary action.

5. Disobedience, attempt at copying or prompting in examinations and other delinquencies shall be dealt with severely.

6. All the vehicles must be kept in the parking areas meant from them.

7. Male students are permitted to wear pants and half hand shirts only. The shirt should be neatly tucked in wearing of jeans and T-shirts is prohibited during working hours.

8. Girl students are permitted to wear sarees only.

9. Male students are to have their hair neatly cut and combed. Long flowing hair and any other style are not permitted in the institution.

10. All students are expected to wear their identity cards provided at all times.

11. All students are expected to be punctual and attend all the classes. Late attendance and absence in one of the classes will be treated as absent for half a day.

12. Students will also have to complete assignments, seminars and exams that will be conducted in the respective subjects from time to time.

13. Every student should compulsorily participate in camp activities, awareness programmes and sports events.

14. Students should not bring mobile phone to their classes. Any mobile phone will be handed over at the end of the year.

15. Any kind of misbehaviour found in between the is liable for serious disciplinary action.
